OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: CHSS: Reimbursement of vaccination charges under COVID-19- reg

The COVID-19 pandemic has affected the entire country. As a result of the spike in the positivity rate of the COVID-19 virus, the Central Govt. has stepped up its efforts to ensure that majority of the population is vaccinated so as to contain the spread of the virus.

2. In order to ensure that maximum number of CHSS beneficiaries are vaccinated, Centres may provide vaccination through tie-up with private hospitals. Further, all CHSS beneficiaries can directly avail of the vaccination facilities in private hospitals with the following conditions:

- (a) Reimbursement of vaccination charges will be at **actuals** and subject to a maximum of **Rs. 1200/- per dose + facilitation/administrative charges**, if any, charged by the vaccinating institutions.
- (b) Reimbursement towards vaccination charges is restricted to **2 doses only**.
- (c) Administrative heads may ensure that reimbursement towards 2 doses of the same may be made **only** on production of a **valid certificate** as proof of the same.

3. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
