OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : Reckoning of Two Additional Increments in respect of Scientists/Engineers in the Grades from SD to SG for the purpose of revision of Pension of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01.01.2016.

The two additional increments to the Scientists/Engineers from the Grades SD to SG was given as a special package in 1996 and the amount of additional increments were revised from time to time. Subsequently, vide Department OM No.A.2/10(8)/98-I (Vol. VIII), dated 20.01.2014, read with OM of even number, dated 22.05.2014, treated the incentive in the form of two additional increments to the Scientists/Engineers in the Grades of SD, SE, SF & SG as pay towards pension with effect from 01.01.1996.

2. Consequent on the implementation of Government's decisions on the recommendations of the 7th CPC, the revision of pension of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners has to be revised in accordance with the instructions contained in the DP&PW OM No.38/37/2016-P&PW(A), dated 12.05.2017 read with the OM of even number, dated 06.07.2017 and 18.07.2017.

3. Consequent to the above, certain doubts have been raised by the Centres/Units, with regard to the method of reckoning the sum of two additional increments drawn by the retired Scientists/Engineers in the Grade of SD, SE, SF and SG towards notional revision of pre-2016 pension/family pension with effect from 01.01.1996. In this connection, the fixation formulae to revise the notional pension/family pension of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01.01.2016 after taking into account the two additional increments drawn by the above said Scientists/Engineers at the time of retirement, is as follows:

- i) The notional pension/family pension shall be arrived at in accordance with the provisions of the DP&PW OM No.38/37/2016-P&PW(A), dated 12.05.2017 read with the OM of even number, dated 06.07.2017 and 18.07.2017.
- ii) The quantum of two additional increments will notionally be reckoned distinctly at the rates prescribed by the Department from time to time corresponding to their Pay Scales/Pay Bands/Levels in the Pay Matrix of respective Pay Commissions.

3.1 To illustrate:

Mr X retired as Scientist/Engineer SF on 31.03.1996 in the Scale of Pay of Rs.14,300-18300. At the time of his retirement, his Basic Pay was Rs. 14,700/- . He was drawing an amount of Rs.800/- (Rs.400 x 2) towards his two additional increments.

Scale of Pay/Pay in the Pay Band & Grade Pay at the time of Retirement :


Basic Pay from 01.04.1996 to 31.12.2005 : Rs.14,700 plus Rs.800 (2 AI)
Basic Pay from 01.01.2006 to 31.12.2015 : Rs.46,100 plus Rs.2,770(2 AI)
Basic Pay from 01.01.2016 : Rs.1,23,100 plus Rs.7400(2 AI)

Notional Pay and Revised Pension as per 7th CPC as on 01.01.2016 :

Notional Pay as on 01.01.2016	:	Rs.1,23,100 plus Rs.7,400/- = Rs.1,30,500/-
Revised Pension payable w.e.f. 01.01.2016	:	Rs.61,550 plus Rs.3,700/- = Rs.65,250/-

4. In view of the above, pending cases of revision of pension/family pension, if any, may be processed expeditiously.
